

PRIVACY POLICY

Calabria Family Wines is committed to maintaining the privacy and confidentiality of your personal information. We will adhere to the National Privacy Principles (NPPs) when collecting, using, disclosing, securing and providing access to personal information.

We endeavor to take all reasonable steps to protect your personal data, but cannot guarantee the security of any data you disclose online. By supplying us with information, you accept the inherent security implications of dealing online over the Internet and will agree not to hold Calabria Family Wines responsible for any breach of security unless we have been negligent or in willful default of our duties to you.

Individuals have a right to request access to personal information that we hold about them. If you believe that your personal <u>information we</u> hold about you is not accurate, you may request that we correct it.

INFORMATION COLLECTION AND USE

Calabria Family Wines collects and is the sole owner of the information collected on this site. Your privacy is important to us, and we will not sell, share with, or rent personal information to others in ways different from what is disclosed in this statement. We will always comply fully with the National Privacy Principles set out in the Privacy Act 1988 (the Act), as they apply to us.

Calabria Family Wines collects information from our users at several different points on our web site:

REGISTRATION

During registration a user is required to give their contact information (such as name and email address). This information is used to deliver wine orders made through our online store and contact the user about the services on our site for which they have expressed interest.

NEWSLETTER

If a user wishes to subscribe to our newsletter, we ask for contact information such as name and email address. The contact information is used to send the newsletter and other information to you.

SECURITY

This web site takes every precaution to protect our users' information off-line. All of our users' personal information, not just the sensitive information mentioned above, is restricted in our offices. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job (for example a customer service representative) are granted access to personal information.

CORRECTION/UPDATING PERSONAL INFORMATION

We are happy to provide you with details of all your personal records at your request. There are certain exemptions that may apply to the provision of that information.
