From the great era of the Roaring Twenties, Prohibition gave rise to the infamous 'Queens of Prohibition'. During this dry period myths were born and the stories of bootleggers; such as Maggie Bailey became legends and set the path for wine distribution around the world.

MARLBOROUGH SAUVIGNON BLANC

TASTING NOTE Flavourful and refreshing this wine opens with lifted notes of passionfruit, tropical fruits and bright lime citrus. Subtle herbaceous undertones add freshness, while the acidity provides balance and drive, finishing clean and lively.

SUGGESTED CUISINE Fresh oysters, Goat Cheese and Herb Crostini, Citrus Marinated Grilled Chicken and seafood ceviche.

SEASON Marlborough had a superb vintage, well above average quality and yields. The fruit remained clean with vibrant flavours and the resulting wines look outstanding. A cooler growing season helped to develop great depth of flavour and bright natural acidity in the fruit.
